Greetings from Bishop's House, Balasore.

COMMUNIO INDIA

The CCBI has launched 'Communio India' in 2018 with a purpose of establishing a missionary organisation like 'Missio', 'Aid to the Church In Need' in Germany. This would help the church in India to build a culture of sharing and caring in solidarity with the needy of our country. This also is an opportune time to encourage the faithful to pray and help the missions and missionaries. The idea of establishing COMMUNIO INDIA is to raise funds in our country, with a view to help the Mission Dioceses and Religious Congregations for the various needs which they require while engaging themselves in the missionary activities in India.
